Introduction:

Nanotechnology is the enabling technology that allows us to develop materials with improved or totally new properties. Changing the properties of material particles without affecting their chemical composition can now be easily achieved utilizing nanotechnology. The building and construction sector will inevitably be a beneficiary with nanotechnology due to its significant impact in improving the physical and mechanical properties of the materials. Therefore, it is considered to be the base of future technologies. The application of nanotechnology can be of great help in innovating green and sustainable construction.

This series of conferences started in 2009. The conference gathered participants from different countries in the world and provided a platform for discussions and reporting about research results. HBRC and ERU agreed upon organizing the current conference to explore potentials and facilitate the cooperation in nanotechnology fields.

Objectives:

Guidelines for preparation of papers:

Summaries and full texts of papers should be submitted in electronic form prepared in MS word 2003/2016. Manuscripts must be formatted as max. of 12 pages, paper size A4, font Times New roman, font size 12, single line spacing, margins (Top, Bottom, right, left) 25 mm. The text should include the title, authors names, degree, position, institution, telephone number, email address, abstract (1 paragraph) and keywords (5-8). All figures and tables should be enumerated and entitled.

2. Nanoscale Materials Characterization.
3. Nanocomposites / Nanostructured / nanoporous Materials.
4. Nanomaterials for structural Health Monitoring and sensing.

6. Nanomaterials for architecture, energy efficiency, environment, clean and sustainable technology.
7. Fire Protection using Nano-technology.
